



The Nile Delta is found at the end of the Nile, where the Nile River itself splits into 2 branches just North of Cairo: the Rushid Branch In the West and the Damietta Branch In the East. The river then divides further into hundreds of canals, that spread the water of the Nile to Egypt's most fertile land, the Delta, where more than 30 million Egyptians live.

The Delta includes the large area between the Egyptian cities of Cairo-Alexandria-Port Said. Cairo is Egypt's capital city of 20 million people; Alexandria is on the Mediterranean and has 5 million people; Port Said is the door of the Suez Canal connecting East and West shipping lanes and has 1 million people.

This part of Egypt is rarely visited by tourists and we have several unique and genuine friendships with local Egyptians, who will introduce you to this historical and hospitable area of Egypt.

**Experience the adventure** : see the end of the Nile River as it enters the Mediterranean Sea, enjoy sunset with fishermen on their boats, participate in farm life, try your hand at weaving the old woolen Kilim carpets, visit the ancient mosques, and walk through the narrow streets and markets, always enjoying time in some local homes and cafes meeting the people.
